

Instructions for completing the MDC QSO Party Summary Sheet

1. This is a pretty simple form to complete. In the first block enter your name, call sign, address, etc.
2. In block labeled "QSO Points" count up the total number of each QSO type. Multiply the number of each QSO type by the QSO Value for each QSO Type and Enter the number in the appropriate Sub-Total. Add each of the Sub-Total values to determine your Total QSO Points. Enter your total QSO Points in the appropriately labeled cell in the block at the bottom of the page labeled "Multipliers".
3. In the block labeled "Category" place and "**X**" in the cell to the left of the category in which you operated.
4. You may claim endorsements to any operating category by placing an "**X**" in the cell to the left of the endorsement type.
 - a. **YL** – You must be a female. We will take your word for it. In the Club category this endorsement can only be applied if **all** of the participants are YLs.
 - b. **VHF/UHF Only** – All of your contacts must have been made on the VHF and/or UHF bands.
 - c. **Licensed Youth** – You must be under the age of 18 years and operate all contacts using your own license.
 - d. **Youth w/Control Op** – You must be under the age of 18 years, and have made at least one of your contacts with the aid of a control operator.
5. In the block labeled "*MDC County and City Checklist*" draw a line through each County and City worked. Count them and enter the total in the appropriately labeled cell in the block at the bottom of the page labeled "*Multipliers*" **This is done for every contest entry.**
6. **This is ONLY for participants from Maryland and the District of Columbia.** In the block labeled "*49 States and 9 Canadian Provinces Checklist*" draw a line through each State and Province that you worked. Count them and enter the total in the appropriately labeled cell at the bottom of the page labeled "*Multipliers*".
7. **This is ONLY for participants from Maryland and the District of Columbia.** List the DX countries you worked during the contest (except Canada) on the back of the Summary Sheet. Count them and enter the total in the appropriately labeled cell in the block at the bottom of the page labeled "*Multipliers*". Since Alaska and Hawaii are states you can't claim them as DX.
8. Add your multipliers and enter total in cell labeled "**Total Multipliers**" and then *multiply* the "**Total Multipliers**" by the "**Total QSO Points**" then add 50 bonus points if you contacted the host station, W3VPR, and you arrive at the "**Total Claimed Score**".
